

July 15, 2015

The Scio Town Board meeting began at 7pm with the supervisor Dan Fleming calling the meeting to order with The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Board Members Present: Dan Fleming, Marcia Habberfield, Jeff Kinney, Wrexie Ames, Kim Demick.

Attendees: 11

Motion to approve prior meeting minutes made by Marcia Habberfield and seconded by Jeff Kinney. All in favor aye vote approved.

Code Enforcement: Monthly report from Code Enforcement Officer copied and passed around for review.

Dog Control: Monthly report copied and passed out for review. Court appearance tickets given out for delinquent do license renewals.

Highway: Superintendent reviewed with the board the projects that have been completed and projects that are scheduled to be done. One of the town trucks will not pass inspection and highway superintendent is looking to find a replacement.

Water: Town agreed to credit the account of a resident for a fee that they had been charged to find that their water was frozen in pipes that were the town's responsibility to take care of.

Monthly abstracts and totals are kept on file in the clerk's office for review during regular business hours.

Judge Ames: \$2,353.00

Judge Whitney: \$4,602.00

Review of Bills: A motion was made by Jeff Kinney to approve the monthly bills as submitted and was seconded by Kim Demick. All in favor aye vote approved.

Bookkeepers Report: A motion was made by Marcia Habberfield to accept the bookkeepers report as stated by the bookkeeper and was seconded by Wrexie Ames. All in favor aye vote approved.

Concerns: Highway worker Glenn Nickerson announced that he will be retiring November 30th, 2015. He updated the board about the status of his health insurance after retirement. A couple of Scio Fire Dept. members were present to discuss the improvements and a timeline with the board in regards to the work being done in the community center, kitchen and the fire hall side. The firemen gave the board a copy of the last agreement on file between the firemen, the firemen's auxiliary and the Town of Scio or other organizations for the use of the

kitchen and the kitchen equipment. The supervisor informed the board that the new flooring will be paid for by the Scio Lions Club; no date yet as to when it will be installed. A Scio resident wanted to know if she could remove her sidewalk rather than putting a new one in or having to maintain what is there; the supervisor will check with the town's attorney. Board member Wrexie Ames shares with the rest of the board town laws that she found stating that the town is responsible for the sidewalks, regardless of who may have installed them.

Supervisor: Budget to actuals were discussed. The town board has agreed to waive the fee for the Fire and Safety Inspections done by the Code Enforcement Officer for the first year because it has been so long since it has been done. This was voted on by the board with Jeff Kinney making the motion, Wrexie Ames seconding it and an all in favor aye vote approving it. Kim Demick made a motion to send a retired employee a bill for their portion (40%) of their health insurance cost for all of 2014, up to present month in 2015; Wrexie Ames seconded the motion and an all in favor aye vote approval was made.

Public Hearing for Local Law Establishing Regulations for Sidewalk Maintenance in the Town of Scio was cancelled so that the board could further discuss this and gather more information.

Public Hearing for Local Law Establishing Regulations Regarding Liability of the Town of Scio in Certain Actions was voted on with Marcia Habberfield making a motion to pass, Wrexie Ames seconding the motion and an all in favor aye vote approval made.

Final Meeting with Supervisor Dan Fleming is set for Thursday July 30th, 2015 at 7pm.

Next Meeting: Wednesday August 12th, 2015 at 7pm.

Jeff Kinney made a motion to adjourn with Kim Demick seconding the motion.
