

June 10, 2015

The Scio Town Board meeting began at 7pm with the supervisor Dan Fleming calling the meeting to order with The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Members Present: Dan Fleming, Marcia Habberfield, Wrexie Ames, Jeff Kinney. Absent: Kim Demick.

Town Clerk absent. Wrexie Ames took notes.

Motion to approve minutes of last meeting made by Marcia Habberfield and seconded by Jeff Kinney. All in favor aye vote approved.

Water Dept: Discussed additional cost of maintenance to SCADA system. Dave Glass to check into another service provider for maintenance on towers and radios.

Highway Dept: New septic system has been put in at the town barns and roof is coming along good. Employee for highway department spoke with the board about his upcoming retirement, his health insurance information after retirement and receiving 4 weeks vacation pay that is owed to him.

Monthly abstract and totals are kept on file in the clerk's office for review during business hours.

Judge Ames: \$1,406.00

Judge Whitney: \$2,667.00

Concerns: Scio residents addressed some issues of possible animal cruelty by another resident, as well as health and safety concerns at that property. Code Enforcement officer will be notified. Another resident approached the board about wanting to install/maintenance a sidewalk in town near the school and asked if the town would consider paying half the cost. This discussion was tabled to a later date. Town Historian discussed with the board some concerns about historical papers/artifacts that the town library board is considering getting rid of.

Review of Bills: A motion to approve the monthly bills was made by Jeff Kinney and seconded by Wrexie Ames. All in favor aye vote approved.

Supervisor: Board of Assessment Review had 10 hours of overtime for the reval. All are in agreement on \$50.00 for their time. Board talked about doing a resolution to borrow money to cover the cost of the new septic and roof for the town barns and any work that needs to be done on the kitchen in the community center. The Town of Scio highway union rep. checked and said that it would be ok for the highway department and the water department to share an employee and belong to the union.
