The Scio Town Board meeting began at 7pm with the supervisor Dan Fleming calling the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Members: Dan Fleming, Wrexie Ames, Kim Demick, Jeff Kinney. Marcia Habberfield absent.

Attendees: 3.

Motion to approve minutes from last meeting made by Wrexie Ames and seconded by Jeff Kinney. All in favor aye vote approved.

Code Enforcement: 1 Building permit application taken in for a building inspection needed to get a Certificate of Compliance for a new Ice Cream Parlor in town. Complaints have been made about a local auto body business to board members. COE has been notified to stop in at business location and send a written response to the board of his findings and any actions that need to be taken.

Water Department: A couple more water leaks have been repaired and working diligently to find other small leaks. Water supervisor also working with Rural Water to help pinpoint problem areas and use their more updated equipment for leak detecting. Supervisor has spoken to local business about doing the much needed cleaning of the town's water wells so that they will work much more efficiently and as soon as the weather breaks they will be able to perform this service.

Highway Department: Highway supervisor gave the board a list of all the roads that are due to be worked on this summer. Board gave permission for a large expense on necessary parts (springs, rotors, misc. other parts) to fix Mack truck.

Dog Control: Monthly report copied and passed out for review.
