The Scio Town Board meeting began at 6:27pm with the supervisor Kim Demick calling the meeting to order with The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Board Members: Kim Demick, Wrexie Ames, Crystal Wiech, Marcia Habberfield, Pete Farwell.

Motion to approve minutes of last meeting as written was made by Marcia Habberfield and seconded by Crystal Wiech. All in favor aye vote approved.

Dog Control: Monthly report was copied and passed out for review, with a copy being kept on file in the clerk's office.

Code Enforcement: Monthly report copied and passed out for review, with a copy being kept on file in the clerk's office. Adoption of Local Law #1 of the year 2016 : Providing for the Administration and Enforcement of the New York State Uniform Fire Prevention and Building Code was done at the public hearing right before the regular monthly board meeting to take effect immediately following the receipt and approval of the Secretary of State.

Water Dept.: Motion to approve the monthly water bills was made by Marcia Habberfield and seconded by Pete Farwell. All in favor aye vote approved. SCADA is fixed and in full working order. Budget to actual was discussed.

Highway Dept.: Motion to approve monthly highway bills was made by Pete Farwell and seconded by Wrexie Ames. All in favor aye vote approved. Budget to actual was reviewed. Highway Superintendent Skip Nickerson updated the board on the equipment that is in need of repairs.

reconciliation audited by the supervisor. Shared thank you note for a memorial donation. Shared information with the board in regards to the possibility of doing hunting/fishing licenses again in the future.

Supervisor: Discussion was had between board members, residents and emergency personnel in regards to the 2017 Ambulance Contract. Bids were received from both Amity and Wellsville for just ambulance service, as the rescue service will be handled by the Scio Fire Dept. Amity said they did not have the paperwork needed from the state to be able to service our area but would be willing to get that to have for future talks. Board voted unanimously to approve the 2017 Wellsville Ambulance contract. Board members discussed the tentative budget figures for the 2017 budget. Discussed union contracts. Public hearing was set for Wednesday November 2nd, 2016 at 6:30pm in the main office in the community building.
