Skip said the paving of the parking lot here at community building is finished. He has appointment on Monday for chips paper work to get finished. Track on doors @ shop need some repairs done. Calling Overhead Door to do the work. Hit a gas

line at Barlows, very minor but may get a bill. Reported \$93,000 left to carry over after chips is figured out.
