The springs are flowing well. There are 3 meters that are not working. We have 5-6 new ones that we can use to replace those that are not working. Need to make this a priority to have all meters working because we are losing revenue. Receive bill from Skata, Kim to review.

Highway Dept.: Motion to approve the monthly highway bills was made by Pete Farwell and seconded by Marica Habberfield. All in favor aye vote approved. The purchase of the new trailer will happen when Angelica receives their new one. The Ford is fixed and runs good. GMC we will get estimate of selling value. City of Olean may have some used trucks to purchase. We will not be getting any storm reimbursement. 250 ton of salt has been ordered. We have to take at least 175 ton. The survey has been completed between the town property and Nickerson's. Need to get the fence installed later this summer. Installed the pump on the roller and it is still not working. It maybe air locked. We will need to have someone look at it. We will start hauling stone and try to be finished by the end of June. Water Dept. fuel used in 2016 was \$1285.96.
