Highway Dept: Motion to approve the monthly highway bills was made by Crystal Wiech and seconded by Jennifer Goodridge. All in favor aye vote approved. Skip gave a list of bridges to be painted. A total of 5 and estimated \$1150.00 to do all. Discussed overtime hours allotted for the year is 360 hrs. and as of right now they are at 202. Dylan worked 7.5 hours overtime for the highway department. The International truck ended up being the injectors and around \$1800.00 at the Alfred tech school. The mack truck was taken to Portville for exhaust work and estimated around \$1200-1500. The 09 Red GMC truck has had major problems and has been worked on by Jeff Culbertson and also taken to Portville for fuel line replacement. Ready to get rid of it. New truck will cost between \$20,000.00 and 30,000.00. Skip would like to trade in his old phone for a new phone and just get

paid his regular amount of \$50.00 monthly. The board agreed. The highway office is coming along with its updates.
