The Scio Town Board meeting began at 6:30pm with the deputy supervisor Wrexie Ames calling the meeting to order with reciting the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Water Dept: Motion to approve the monthly water bills was made by Jennifer Goodridge and seconded by Crystal Wiech. All in favor aye vote approved. Dylan spoke about the software he uses and that it needs to be updated. It is 10 years old. If we were to purchase new outright, it would cost about \$11,000.00, but if we did the census support for 1 year the cost would be \$2144.94 and it would update us up to today's date. Lights on outside of town building are all fixed except one back corner. He needs to find bulbs.

Highway Dept: Motion to approve the monthly highway bills was made by Wrexie Ames and seconded by Jennifer Goodridge. All in favor aye vote approved. Skip said the guys worked from 9:30am to 6:30pm on July 4th. They have agreed to take time and a half off instead of overtime. The ford truck had fuel system worked on and cost \$2400.00. We discussed trash clean-up and Skip checked with the dump and white goods can be dropped there at no fee, but any freezers, refrigerators with liquid would be a \$10.00 fee. The dump does not take any brush. The pothole on side of building has been filled. Skip will be off 1st part of August.
