The Scio Town Board meeting began at 6:30pm with the supervisor Kim Demick calling the meeting to order with reciting the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Board Members: Kim Demick, Wrexie Ames, Crystal Wiech, Jennifer Goodridge.

Absent: Pete Farwell

Attendees: 10

Concern of Attendees: Church Street neighbors are concerned with the two empty abandoned homes becoming a dangerous situation for residents due to the wild animals in and around the homes. Children and pets possibly being bitten. The board notified them that the CEO is aware of the situation and has spoken to the owners. The board will keep up with the progress of getting things taken care of. Resident on Wolf Spring road is concerned about ditch in front of couple of properties. He was explained to get ahold of the highway supervisor on the situation.

Dog Control: Report is on file in the clerks office.

Code Enforcement: Report is on file in the clerks office.

Assessor: No report available by meeting day.

Water Dept: Motion to approve the monthly water bills was made by Crystal Wiech and seconded by Wrexie Ames. All in favor aye vote approved. Dylan's contract has been approved by the board. He is now a salary employee. Dylan had a burial last week and believes that makes 3 so far. Supervisor has asked Dylan to look into some potential property with water wells on it.

Highway Dept: Motion to approve the monthly highway bills was made by Kim Demick and seconded by Wrexie Ames. All in favor aye vote approved. The 09 GMC had a brake caliber break and had to have work done on it. Cost was around \$800.00. Needed to be done so it could be traded or replaced in future with no idea yet on time frame for that. The International truck broke down again and they took it back to Alfred State. They got it running again and will send back to them in the fall for them to finish on making it better. The ford had some work

done. Fixed, but not bill yet. The clutch fan and sensor needed replaced. Skip has asked about the safety t-shirts from the state, if they can be covered from the town and not part of their clothing allowance. The board has agreed since it is state mandatory.
