

Sept. 12th, 2018

The Scio Town Board meeting began at 6:30pm with the supervisor Kim Demick calling the meeting to order with reciting the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Board Members: Kim Demick, Crystal Wiech and Jennifer Goodridge.

Dog Control: Report on file in Town Clerks office.

Code Enforcement: No report available by meeting day.

Assessor: No report available by meeting day.

Water Dept: Dylan was absent from the meeting but called in. Not much to report, he did have to change the battery for the generator. Motion to accept the water bills was made by Jennifer Goodridge and seconded by Crystal Wiech. All in favor aye vote approved.

Highway Dept: Motion to approve the monthly highway bills was made by Crystal Wiech and seconded by Jennifer Goodridge. All in favor aye vote approved. Skip discussed selling the town truck or taking it to auction. Skip wasn't guaranteed he would get \$10,000.00 for it, but would guarantee \$6500.00. Skip feels it is worth more and maybe could get \$12,000 - \$15,000 for it. Spoke about the town purchasing a 2006 GMC 5500 truck for \$25,000 which also included a new plow, wing, stainless body and sander. Kim made a motion to purchase the 2006 Mac single axle for \$25,000 delivered to highway department. Crystal Wiech seconded it. All in favor aye vote approved. Skip said work on sealing will use all his chips up and won't be getting reimbursed \$140,000 until December 2018. Also stated he will need about \$2000 more for gravel. Board approved the amount. Kris Carlin agreed to only charge the town 1 hour service time when he is called out. He could charge up to 3 but is being generous to only charge for 1, thank you Kris. Skip said he would like to see new town truck, an excavator and a trammatizing tractor with side mower for the town. He will come up with some pricing and the town board will discuss it. The Hazard Mitigation Plan will be kept at Highway Dept.

Kim Demick made a motion to accept minutes from the previous month's meeting. Seconded by Jennifer Goodridge. All in favor aye vote approved.

Motion to approve the monthly general bills was made by Crystal Wiech and seconded by Kim Demick. All in favor aye vote approved.

Bookkeepers Report: Bookkeeper submitted report.

Town Clerk: Monthly reports passed around for review with a copy being kept on file in the clerk's office.

The town board received a resignation letter from Deputy Supervisor Wrexie Ames. Kim made a motion to accept Wrexie's resignation. Jennifer Goodridge seconded it. All in favor aye vote approved.

Kim Demick with the power to do so, appointed Crystal Wiech as the new Deputy Supervisor.

Motion to add Crystal as a signing and depositing personnel for Steuben Trust and removing Wrexie Ames as a signing and depositing personnel. Jennifer Goodridge seconded. All in favor aye vote approved.

Town Board has decided to stay with Chuck Cagle as our CEO and chose to forego the Caneadea consortium.

Connie Green was appointed as the new Hall cleaner.

The town board is all in favor of using shared services with the Rushford Assessor Consortium.
