The Scio Town Board meeting began at 6:30pm with the supervisor Kim Demick calling the meeting to order with reciting the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Board Members: Kim Demick, John Ramsey, Crystal Wiech, Jennifer Goodridge and Kyle Spier.

Concern of Attendee: Resident on State Rt. 19 was asking for an update on the status of a neighbor and some legal issues.

Dog Control: No report available by meeting day.

Code Enforcement: Stopped in at the meeting to report nothing new and no complaints.

Assessor: No report available by meeting day.

Water Dept: Motion to approve the monthly water bills was made by John Ramsey and seconded by Kim Demick. All in favor aye vote approved. The board approved the water department audit. Dylan explained he changed out 1 meter and will be replacing a 2nd one that froze and broke. Dylan talked about Eldorado update. Has not been done in years. Discussion regarding what were our guaranteed improvements and the possibility the update hadn't been done in so long it may be detrimental to the system. Dylan will do more checking. Board agreed that there will be a \$25.00 additional charge added to digs (graves) and fill ins. The town clerk was asked to look and see if the Operation Ordinance for Management and control for the town water policy was ever implemented, if not we will bring back next month with edits. Dylan will be giving a plan for his 2019 projects at next months meeting.

Highway Dept: Motion to approve the monthly highway bills was made by Jennifer Goodridge and seconded by Crystal Wiech. All in favor aye vote approved. Skip was given a quote for overhead shop doors of \$1932.90. Kim Demick made a motion to approve the overhead doors in the amount of \$1932.90

for Highway Barn repair. Seconded by Kyle Spier. All in favor aye vote approved. The block wall at the shop fell in and will cost about \$100.00 to \$200.00 to replace and fix with wood. Skip said the highway department will be ordering more reflective signs and posts. The town really needs some new ones put up. They will use any that they have and then see what is needed. Skip will get a quote for yield signs. A new sluice pipe is needed up on Bill Allen Hill Rd and will cost roughly \$5322.00. Skip is asking for the town board to consider a proposal of fulltime 20 hrs. highway and 20 hrs. water. Board discussed the need for water must first be established, then spoke of minimally part time highway. Skip could really use the help with plowing the roads for the next winter season, especially when someone is off or sick. The town board will talk it over and decide. Skip also stated that his 2008 truck is falling apart and we are in need of another, which could cost between \$20 to \$25,000.00. The driveway policy has been added to the policy book.

Kim Demick made a motion to accept minutes from the previous month's meeting. Seconded by John Ramsey. All in favor aye vote approved.

Motion to approve the monthly general bills was made by Kim Demick and seconded by Jennifer Goodridge. All in favor aye vote approved.

Town Clerk: Monthly reports passed around for review with a copy being kept on file in the clerk's office.

Resolution # 17 has been added and states that the cost of foil request or copies made for purposes outside normal business activity will be charged \$1.00 per page plus mailing expense. Mailing expense can be avoided if picked up in person. Motion made by Crystal Wiech and seconded by John Ramsey. All in favor aye vote approved.
