The Scio Town Board meeting began at 6:30pm with Supervisor Kim Demick calling the meeting to order with The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Water Dept.: Oakley Sortore was hired November 11th as our designated water operator. Board discussed Health Departments possible violation for a few days without a certified operator. Thank you, Dan Jordan for keeping the water system safe everyday!! Dan stated that the scada system is working fine due to colder weather.
