

October 9th, 2019

The Scio Town Board meeting began at 6:30pm with the supervisor Kim Demick calling the meeting to order with reciting the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Board Members: Kim Demick, Crystal Wiech, Jennifer Goodridge and Kyle Spier.

Absent: John Ramsey

Dog Control: No report available by meeting day.

Code Enforcement: No report available by meeting day.

Assessor: No report available by meeting day.

Water Dept: Town Board discussed the situation with Dylan working for the Highway department to pay for fuel and have decided that Dylan will no longer be working for the highway and the water department will pay for the fuel. If he is needed to help highway out, he will be compensated. Board has asked Dylan to again check with other towns on their systems so the Town of Scio can get a new system. The board would like some feedback on other towns recommendations before deciding what system would be best to get. Motion to accept the water bills was made by Kyle Spier and seconded by Crystal Wiech. All in favor aye vote approved.

Highway Dept: Motion to approve the monthly highway bills was made by Crystal Wiech and seconded by Jennifer Goodridge. All in favor aye vote approved. Skip notified the board that the plow blades, which costs \$4100.00 will be here in a week. Stated that he is low on equipment reserves. The sale of equipment totaled \$17,000.00. We have \$10,000 left in machinery and will use some of this for the plow. Kim Demick made a motion to accept the 2020-2022 snow removal and ice contract with the county baring any issues with appendix B and C and Skip is to give his ok. This was seconded by Jennifer Goodridge. All in favor aye vote approved. Skip also spoke of hiring Robert Stilson to replace Bill Blovet starting October 21st. Kim made a motion to hire Robert Stilson. This was seconded by Jennifer Goodridge. All in favor aye vote approved.

Crystal Wiech made a motion to accept minutes from the previous month's meeting. Seconded by Jennifer Goodridge. All in favor aye vote approved.

Town Clerk: Monthly reports passed around for review with a copy being kept on file in the clerk's office.

Concerns of Attendees: A concerned citizen voiced his concern over the rules and regulations on use of Town land for hunting and shooting. Someone has been going through his property, tearing it up and shooting within 500 ft. of his property. The town has posted signs with no hunting but it is not stopping them. Dylan agreed to meet with the resident and walk the land where this is going on. Kim Demick asked Dylan about the posted signs and Dylan replied he has posted signs somewhat and Kim instructed Dylan to go back and thoroughly post the area. The board explained to the resident that there is not to be any hunting or shooting on the town land and the resident is encouraged to call the DEC or troopers to prevent this. The board along with Dylan will be investigating this situation to get to the bottom of it.

Supervisor: Kim made a motion to accept the 2020 ambulance contract with the Wellsville Ambulance bid of \$4321.00. Crystal Wiech seconded it. All in favor aye vote approved.

Kim made a motion to approve The Charter contract for 15 years. Seconded by Jennifer Goodridge. All in favor aye vote approved.

The abstract totals for the month were water \$5358.11, General \$14,510.75, Highway \$14510.75, and Street Lights \$1509.35
