The Scio Town Board meeting began at 6:30pm with Supervisor Kim Demick calling the meeting to order with The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Board Members: Kim Demick, Jennifer Goodridge, Kyle Spier, Jon Elliott and Alissa Ramsey

Attendee: 2

Dog Control: No report as of meeting time.

Code Enforcement: No report as of meeting time.

Water Dept.: Nate Jenison was absent from the meeting. Jon Elliott made the motion to accept the water bills and Kyle Spier seconded it. All in favor aye vote approved.

Highway Dept.: Skip brought up the fact of maybe going with a smaller tractor then previously discussed, but after a lengthy discussion, the board will let Skip decide if we get larger or smaller tractor and board will vote next month. Christmas decorations will be going up next week and also turned on!! A load of firewood came in and Skip notified board that the highway's hours will be changing to 6am – 2:30pm on Monday November 16th, 2020. The board discussed with Skip that they will be setting a side from his budget, \$20,000 per year for the purchase of equipment and the reserve will carry (roll) over if not used. Jennifer Goodridge made the motion to accept the highway bills and Jon Elliott seconded it. All in favor aye vote approved.

Supervisor Kim Demick made a motion to approve the 2021 Budget. Jennifer Goodridge seconded it. All in favor aye vote approved.

The Town of Scio voted no for any plan for shared services to the state for 2021.

Kyle Spier made a motion to move to executive session to discuss employee situation at 7:16pm and seconded by Jon Elliott. All in favor. Executive session ended at 7:36pm.

Jon Elliott made a motion to hire MACE as our code enforcement services for 2021. Kim Demick seconded it. All in favor aye vote approved.
