Water Dept: Tonight the board accepted 3 resolutions. Resolution #18 was for delinquent water charges to extend the due date to October 13th, 2020. Resolution #19 was that the Town Board does hereby designate itself as the lead agency for the Town of Scio Water Storage Tank Replacement project. Motion to approve the monthly water bills was made by Jennifer Goodridge and seconded by Kyle Spier. All in favor aye vote approved.

Highway Dept: Motion to approve the monthly highway bills was made by Kyle Spier and seconded by Jennifer Goodridge. All in favor aye vote approved. Skip discussed that the chips amount has been cut by 20%. \$68,788.64 is the amount that is left. Skip is waiting on Monroe tractor for a quote on a tractor without a tramatizer. The 05 truck is in need of some repairs and Kris's truck is going to cost around \$1700.00 to fix. \$2000- \$2500 will be the cost for new signs and will be happening this fall.
