HIGHWAY – Discussion regarding budget items that are over, most likely due to the purchase of the new pick-up truck and unusually high truck repairs this year. Discussion regarding the purchase of a small tractor than originally planned (no traumatizer attachment) but a flail mower plus \$140 for loading rear tires. If we purchase in January, it is likely we will get the CHIPS refund by March 2021. Mr. Nickerson assures the board, that he does not see any issue with CHIPS money being available for this entire purchase.
