

January 13th, 2021

The Scio Town Board meeting began at 6:30pm with Supervisor Kim Demick calling the meeting to order with The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Board Members: Kim Demick, Jennifer Goodridge, Kyle Spier, Alissa Ramsey and Jon Elliott.

Dog Control: Report on file in the clerk's office.

Code Enforcement: Report on file in the clerk's office.

Water Dept.: The board mostly spoke with Nate about the water tank project. Nate did advise the board that he needs some new brass flows. Board went over all bills and Kyle Spier made a motion to accept water bills and seconded by Jon Elliott. All in favor aye vote approved.

Highway Dept.: Skip informed the board that the tractor purchase is getting finalized and the cost of the tractor is \$67,639.00. Also stated that he needs a lap top computer instead of a desktop. He needs to be able to take computer with him to meetings. The board discussed and agreed to purchase a laptop. Skip also gave the board a list of streets that were worked on in Scio during the year of 2020. Those streets were McQueen St.- 1 load of gravel in turn around. Stevens Court – oil and stoned and 1 load of gravel in turn around. Town Roads were Allen- 10 tons of black top. Back River- 1 load gravel in turn around. Barlow- 11 loads of gravel and some ditching. Barnes – 2 loads gravel, cut shoulders and some ditching. Bill Allen Hill – changed 18” sluice pipe in middle of hill. Changed 5’ sluice pipe at beginning of road. Cut shoulders and shimed with hot black top. Coyle Hill– 15 loads of gravel, cut shoulders and ditches from blacktop to top of hill. Davis Hill – Changed 40’ of 18” sluice pipe above water tank. Changed 12” x 30’ driveway sluice pipe at driveway. Ditched in spots. Drum – cut shoulders and ditches and shimed with blacktop and oiled and stoned. Dry Brook – Cut shoulders and ditches, 1 load blacktop and oiled and stoned. Gordon Brook – cut shoulders on upper end also cut ditches. 6 loads of gravel. Hazzard - cut shoulders and ditches. Hunter – 1 load of gravel in turn around. Morgan – cut shoulders and ditches. Morgan Hill – cut shoulders from Merry’s to Peterson Hill Rd. Graveled 6” from Merry’s to Peterson Hill rd. Changed Merry’s driveway pipe and traumatized whole road. Noles – 2 loads of gravel. Palmer – cut shoulders and ditches on upper end. 14 loads of gravel. Peterson Hill – cut shoulders and ditches. 14 loads of gravel and 2 ½ loads blacktop shim. Petrolia Hill – cut shoulders and ditches and shimed with blacktop. Put Brook – cut shoulders and ditches and 1 load of gravel. Shear – 10 loads of gravel. Snowball Hollow – cut shoulders and ditches on upper end. Replaced driveway pipe@ Learns. Did some creek work with excavater. Vossler – 2 loads of gravel. Weinhauer Hill – replaced driveway pipe@ Hinkles. 3 loads of blacktop. Wolf Spring – replaced road crossing pipe by Breezy Point. Put 20’ extension on Empson driveway pipe. 4 loads of blacktop and Yeager Hill - some ditching in spots. Motion to approve highway bills was made by Jon Elliott and seconded by Kyle Spier. All in favor aye vote approved.

Assessor: End of year report in the clerk's office.

Monthly abstract's and totals are kept on file for review in the town clerk's office during regular business hours.

Review of Bills: Motion to approve general bills made by Jennifer Goodridge and seconded by Kyle Spier. All in favor aye vote approved.

Clerks Report: Town Clerk's monthly reports put out for review. Kept on file in the town clerk's office. Motion to accept previous months board minutes was made by Jennifer Goodridge and seconded by Kyle Spier. All in favor aye vote approved.

Supervisor Demick made a motion to accept the December 30th meeting minutes with the deletion of Kyle Spier being in attendance. Seconded by Jon Elliott. All in favor aye vote approved.

An additional \$8700.00 needed to move to a full project. Board agreed to invest \$8700.00 to upgrade the water tank project. Kim Demick made a motion to agree to pay MRB \$8700.00 to amend the Scio Water Storage tank and water main replacement. Seconded by Jennifer Goodridge. All in favor aye vote approved
