The Scio Town Board meeting began at 6:30pm with Supervisor Kim Demick calling the meeting to order with The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Motion to accept the minutes of the last meeting as written was made by Jennifer Goodridge and seconded by Jon Elliott. All in favor aye vote approved.

Dog Control: No report as of meeting.

Code Enforcement: Monthly report being kept on file in the clerk's office.

Water Dept.: Motion to accept the monthly water bills made by Jennifer Goodridge and seconded by Jon Elliott. All in favor aye vote approved. Nate notified the board that we have spent \$3825.00 for water from Wellsville this year. Scio has also spent \$3923.09 on filters since March 2021. Water was tested for magnesium, the well was 0.4 and should be 0.3. The board had a lengthy discussion on the water. Some of Nate's projects for the summer are flushing hydrants and paint a few, paint the trailer and try and get 5/6 meters working that have not been.

Highway Dept.: Motion to accept the monthly highway bills was made by Jon Elliott and seconded by Jennifer Goodridge. All in favor aye vote approved. We have the new mower!!! Skip gave the board all of his road work projects for this summer. The Mac truck fuel tank needed replaced and the cost was \$2200.00. The chips money was raised this year and we have \$210,546.53. Had a discussion on clothing allowances for highway dept as stated in contract.
